WELCOME TO BK HOUSE & GARDENS!

Located on historic Chartres Street in the heart of the French Quarter, BK House & Gardens is one of New Orleans' most iconic Creole homes. Built in 1826 as a private residence, the house sits directly across from the Old Ursuline Convent and has witnessed nearly two centuries of the city's cultural, social, and architectural history.

Unlike many historic venues, BK House was originally designed for gathering. With the largest private ballroom found within a historic home in New Orleans, it offers a scale that is both impressive and deeply intimate—grand without ever feeling overwhelming.

The property unfolds across three distinct spaces: the ballroom, the side garden, and the back courtyard. Together, they allow a wedding to move organically throughout the evening, creating a natural rhythm from ceremony to cocktails to dinner and dancing. Guests experience the house as it was meant to be experienced—layer by layer, room by room, moment by moment.

Today, BK House & Gardens remains a living museum and a carefully stewarded event space. Hosting a wedding here means celebrating within a landmark that is inseparable from the history of the French Quarter itself.
